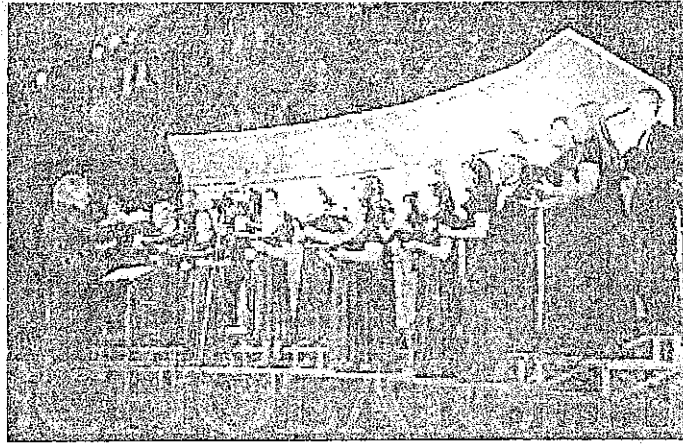

MOBERLY AREA COMMUNITY COLLEGE MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

THE AWARD:

Vocal Scholarship: The number and amount of the individual awards will vary based on talent and need. The award may be used for any educational expenses charged at Moberly Area Community College including fees, tuition, housing, meal plan, and/or books and supplies.

The award is renewable for one consecutive semester as long as the student maintains a cumulative 2.00 grade point average and the student is enrolled in 12 semester hours. The award will be prorated if the recipient fails to abide by the rules and regulations of the scholarship or the College.

Student recipients of this award may reapply in subsequent years.

The vocal scholarship can be used in combination with the Missouri A+ Scholarship. The vocal scholarship is stackable with other institutional scholarships with a limit of two institutional scholarships per student.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Send a completed copy of the enclosed application form, and a letter of recommendation from the appropriate high school ensemble director to: Karen Werner, Associate Professor of Music, Moberly Area Community College, 101 College Ave, Moberly, Missouri 65270.
2. Vocal auditions at the Music Department on the MACC main campus, room 15 Main Building, on Thursday, April 4, and Tuesday, April 9, at 5:00 to 6:30 p.m. Please indicate on your application which date you prefer.
3. Each vocal student must have a solo prepared, and must provide their own accompanist or accompanying CD. All scholarship applicants will audition for the MACC music faculty.

REQUIREMENTS OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS:

1. Must be enrolled in the appropriate performance group each semester at MACC.
2. Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 total college credit hours each semester at MACC.

3. Must play or sing at ALL public performances unless excused due to extenuating circumstances by the ensemble director or the Dean of Academic Affairs.

4. Must attend ALL scheduled rehearsals.

5. Must maintain a 2.0 grade point average.
