2017 COLUMBIAN CHAPTER DAR SCHOLARSHIP

This is a non-renewable monetary award for a high school senior at a public or private school in Boone County, Missouri, who has been accepted to (or whose application is pending to) an **accredited** post-secondary school in the United States. An award of \$500 will be sent to the recipient's choice of a college, university, community college or technical school. Applicants will be evaluated on **academic scholarship** (see below), **dependability** (truthfulness, loyalty, and punctuality); **service** (cooperation, courtesy, and consideration of others); **leadership** (ability to assume responsibility and to motivate others, innovativeness); **volunteerism** (in school, community settings, etc.) and **patriotism** (pride and respect for our country, its history and flag).

CHECKLIST AND APPLICATION

INSTRUCTIONS: Mail the completed application packet to the *Columbian Chapter Scholarship Committee* [address below]. If sent electronically it should be in one PDF file. The application packet must be complete and arranged in the order listed below. **Photographs will result in disqualification and should not be included.** Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin or disability. The application package should not exceed 15 pages. Incomplete applications will not be considered. **NOTE: Download the application, & SAVE to your computer BEFORE filling it in electronically.**

CHECK LIST: Applications must be postmarked or sent electronically by MARCH 1, 2017

Scholarship Application (must be typed or computer generated – see box below).

Essay topic: *Describe something you did in the past year that made a difference in your community.* (max length, 2 pages double-spaced)

Original transcript from your high school: Home schooled students should include transcripts for grade 9 through current year and must be sent with application.

This scholarship requires a minimum grade point average of 3.5 (GPA) based on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent GPA on the scale used by the applicable educational institution This scholarship also requires a minimum ACT score of 27.

List of extra-curricular activities, honors received, scholastic achievements, employment and community service activities. (one page)

Required: Three Letters of Recommendation: 1) *high school faculty member*; 2) *high school principal*; 3) *community member*. Applicants will be disqualified if more than the above three are sent. They should NOT be included with your packet. Letters should be sent directly by the endorser, either electronically to our e-mail address below, or postal mailed.
