

BOONE COUNTY BAR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION DUE APRIL 10, 2017
APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE 2017-2018 ACADEMIC YEAR

The Boone County Bar Association is awarding one scholarship in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the 2017-2018 school year. This scholarship will be awarded to an individual who will pursue higher education in an accredited four-year post-secondary institution.

To be eligible for consideration for this scholarship, the student applying must:

1. Be a full-time resident of Boone County, Missouri.
2. Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
3. Enroll as a full-time undergraduate student in an accredited college or university during the 2017-2018 school year and begin in Fall of 2017.
4. Have shown interest in the legal profession or participated in law or public affairs activities.

How to apply:

1. Applicant must submit most current transcript showing his/her GPA.
2. Complete the application including the essay portion.

ALL APPLICATIONS AND ACCOMPANYING DOCUMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN APRIL 10, 2017.

Applications received after 4:00 p.m. on April 10, 2017, will not be considered.

Applications will not receive consideration if documentation is missing or documents are mailed separately from the application.

Finalists will be contacted for an in-person interview no later than May 1, 2017. Interviews will be completed by May 19, 2017.

Winner will be notified no later than May 30, 2017.
