



## What is the BJC Scholars Fund?

It is a renewable scholarship awarded to a maximum of 14 **new** students annually who reside in communities served by BJC Hospitals: St. Louis City; St. Louis County; St. Charles County; Boone County; Crawford County; and St. Francois County in Missouri; Madison County and St. Clair County in Illinois. It is a need-based award of \$10,000 per academic year, and is renewable through graduation or a maximum of 10 semesters, as long as the student continues to meet eligibility and selection criteria.

To be eligible to be considered for this scholarship you must:

- Be a graduating high school senior planning to enter college as an incoming freshman in the 2017-2018 academic year;
- Plan to attend a public Missouri or Illinois state college or university in your home state, or be receiving in-state reciprocity at a public university \*;
- Meet all eligibility criteria for The Scholarship Foundation Interest-Free Loan; and,
- Complete the two-part application between January 1<sup>st</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup> by visiting [myscholarshipcentral.org](http://myscholarshipcentral.org).
